

## RILEY FLOWER PARADE

We will draw two names on September 28<sup>th</sup> from each classroom to represent that classroom in the parade. This drawing will be done from the students who have returned their permission slips, so parents will know if their child will be representing their room. This is an option we hope we do not have to use. Last year we called the parents of the students representing the rooms when the weather did not cooperate.*
