RE: eLearning Days in January

Greenfield-Central Parents:

In the month of January, Greenfield-Central will have two eLearning days for our students. The first day (January 21st) will serve as a makeup day from our missed day of school on November 15th. The other day (January 30th) is a regularly-scheduled day for teacher professional development. Because the purpose behind each day is different, the structure of each day differs. I want to ensure that our students and parents understand the format and process for each of these distinct days.

Monday, January 21st will be the first of the two eLearning days. This day was originally scheduled as a non-school holiday in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. Unfortunately, the inclement weather we experienced on November 15th required us to cancel school. Therefore, Greenfield-Central students must make up that missed day in order to remain on track and fulfill our requirements for the 2018-19 school year. That missed day will be made up as an Inclement Weather eLearning Day.

- All school facilities will be closed for students and staff. Transportation and lunch services will not be provided.
- All student work will need to be completed on school-supplied digital devices within one week (by January 28th). Students not completing the assigned work may be counted absent for the day.
- Students who do not have internet connectivity will have lab hours at their schools during the evening hours of the week in order to give students the opportunity to complete assignments. Your child's principal will provide more details about these hours.

Wednesday, January 30th has been an identified eLearning Day to allow professional development for the Greenfield-Central faculty and staff. We will conduct business on this day in the same manner that we did on both of our other scheduled eLearning days (September 26th and November 1st).

- Students will have the option of attending school on this day. Families choosing this option will need to notify the school in advance so that we can provide appropriate transportation and ensure that we have enough support for the students attending on this day. Families will use PowerSchool to notify the school. A postcard will be sent to each family with the link to RSVP.
