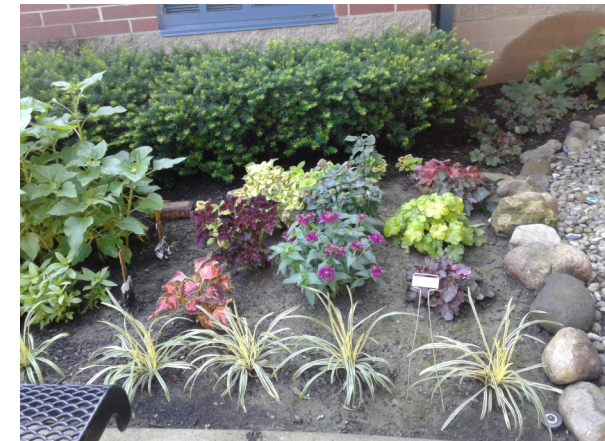
## Explore the 5 Senses
