



COVID-19 Testing Options in Hancock County (as of February 8, 2021):

The top two locations offer rapid PCR testing for **asymptomatic** and **symptomatic** school employees and students. The PCR test detects genetic material in the COVID-19 virus and is considered more reliable and accurate than the antigen test which detects protein fragments in the virus. The most recent guidelines given by the Indiana State Department of Health. ***Please note that if you receive a negative antigen test result, the Indiana Department of Health now requires a negative PCR test prior to students and staff returning to school***
